ORDER

Under the Deregulation 2.0 exercise (PA-06) and directions of the Deregulation Cell, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India, the Labour Department, U.T. Chandigarh has merged the separate application of **building plan approval** with the **factory licence application** under the Factories Act, 1948 read with Punjab Factory Rules, 1952 as applicable to UT, Chandigarh with immediate effect. Henceforth, applicants will no longer be required to file a separate application. Building plans will now be scrutinized as part of the factory licence application process itself, and the online portal has been modified accordingly. The statutory scrutiny of building plans will remain unchanged. This order will remain in force till the notification of Chandigarh Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Rules, 2026.
