In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 55 of the Factories Act, 1948 and consequent upon the approval of the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, the Chief Inspector, Union Territory, Chandigarh exempts all factories registered in the Union Territory, Chandigarh, from the provisions of sub section (1) of section 55 of the aforesaid act subject to the condition that the total number of hours worked by a worker without an interval does not exceed six.

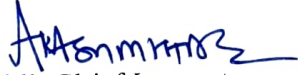
