In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 28 of the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishment Act, 1958 (Punjab Act No. 15 of 1958), the Administrator, Union Territory of Chandigarh hereby grants the following exemptions:

1. That registration certificate under Section 13 of the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishment Act, 1958 shall be granted within one day from the date of submission of online application without prior inspection by the competent authority.
2. The registration fee for issuance of fresh license shall be payable for different categories of shops and establishments through Treasury Challan as per the details specified in the table herein below.
3. The application for grant of fresh license shall be submitted on a prescribed proforma/form alongwith challan receipt, in original. The one-time registration shall be made on self certification basis, subject to applicable rules.
4. That there shall be no requirement for renewal of registration certificate as mandated under sub section 3 of Section 13 of the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishment Act, 1958 except in case of any change in the information provided to the prescribed authority for which provisions of Section 13(4) or 13(5) of the Act ibid are required to be complied with, as the case may be.

The fee structure for grant of fresh license is as under:

3.	All commercial establishments, other than those mentioned above in category 1 & 2 but, employing less than 10 employees.	2000
4.	All shops and commercial Establishments owned and/or managed by the proprietor himself/herself and not employing any employee	1000
5(i)	Bar, Lounge, Breweries, Liquor vends and Taverns (license on annual basis) {As per excise policy of Chandigarh Administration }	1000
5(ii)	Exhibitions/shops/stalls/product launch/display by any company or any other commercial activity done on temporary basis	a) For period of 01 to 07 days @ Rs. 50/- per stall b) For period of


